The Village of Algonquin and the Algonquin Public Arts Commission are proud to present the 3rd annual "Algonquin's Art on the Fox". This fine art show will be held outdoors in beautiful Riverfront Park, which is located along the Fox River in the heart of Historic Downtown Algonquin.

Since 2005, the Algonquin Public Arts Commission has organized the Annual Public Art Program featuring artworks on display for one year in both indoor and outdoor locations throughout the community. Each year this award-winning program exhibits approximately 30 individual works of art on loan from local, regional, & national artists with the overall effect of making Algonquin's place in the Fox River Valley more exceptional.

Application Procedures

We ask that all artists complete the application and submit 4 slides, pictures or a CD of current work and one of their display. Slides should be marked with the artist's name at the top, a dot on the lower left corner (so we know the correct side to view the slide), the medium and the size clearly marked on the bottom. Photos are acceptable with the above information on the back. CDs should have the information on an accompanying document.

Slides, photos & CD's will be returned only if you send a SASE with sufficient postage. Photos of your work may be retained for show promotion & will be returned to you in the artist packet at the show.

We also request a resume & information about you and your work in order to promote your work to the public.

Set Up

Booth space is 10' x 10'. Setup can start at 12 noon, Friday, but there is no security for canopies & displays, they are the artist's liability. Be prepared for uneven or slightly sloped ground. Tear down will not begin until the end of the show.

Sales and Taxes

All proceeds go to the artist. Each artist is responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax (7.75% at printing) on all sales made during the show.

Location

Riverfront Park is located on the Fox River directly North of the Port Edward Restaurant, on North Harrison Street, in Algonquin, Illinois. (The NW corner of the Fox River and Rt. 62/Algonquin Road.)

Fees and Notification

Non-refundable jury fee:	\$15
Exhibit booth fee:	\$50

The \$50 exhibit booth fee will be refunded to any applicant not accepted into the show. Applications & fees must be received by April 1, 2010. Artists will be notified ASAP of acceptance or non-acceptance into the show. Both checks are payable to the Village of Algonquin. Let us know if you wish to be put on the waiting list.

Awards

Judging will take place at 10:00am on Saturday. Awards will be given out on Saturday evening at the artist reception, of which all participating artists are invited.

Eligibility

Algonquin's Art on the Fox is open to all artists. All artwork must be original, designed and executed by the accepted artist. Work done by a production studio is not acceptable. No kits, imports, crafts, manufactured items, resale goods, or product line reps are allowed.

Recommendation

Because of the current economy, we encourage each artist to demonstrate, if possible, thereby drawing clients into their display space to support sales.
