

MINUTES OF
ALGONQUIN, ILLINOIS SPECIAL LIQUOR COMMISSION
HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON JUNE 5, 2012

CALL TO ORDER: With the Village Board seated as the Liquor Commission, Liquor Commissioner John Schmitt opened the meeting at 7:26 p.m.. A roll call showed the following commissioners were present: Debby Sosine, Jim Steigert, Jerrold Glogowski, Robert Smith, Brian Dianis, John Spella. Staff in attendance: William Ganek, Russ Farnum, Russ Laine. Attorney Kelly Cahill and Village Clerk Jerry Kautz were also in attendance.

CONSIDER LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION:

Mr. Schmitt requested that the Liquor Commission consider consenting to the approval of the following liquor license:

Class A-1

KayLarose Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Foley's Pub, 3965-67 West Algonquin Road (former Jimmy D's unit in Prestwicke Plaza), Algonquin, Illinois 60102

Mr. Schmitt reported all filing papers were submitted and in order. Attorney Cahill concurred.

The owner, Mr. David Foley, was asked by Mr. Dianis if BASSET training was given to all employees. He responded by saying their staff will be trained by the opening date and that any new hires would be trained before access to selling. He was advised to use the police BASSET training and to consider a cash register programmed to automatically check IDs. Chief Laine said he had talked to Mr. Foley and both discussed a few minor concerns but that those have been cleared up.

Consensus of the Commission was to advise and consent to this license.
