MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, McHENRY & KANE COUNTIES, IL HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON DECEMBER 4, 2001

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Village President Ted Spella called the regular meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Village Clerk Jerry Kautz Clerk called the roll.

PLEDGE TO FLAG: Clerk Kautz led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

1. Karen Patel and Charlie Eldridge, representing the McHenry County Economic Development Corporation, presented a plan to extend Route 53 from Lake-Cook Road to Grayslake and on to I-94. This plan is to relieve traffic from the north end of Lake and McHenry Counties in future years. They said seven communities in McHenry County and fifty-one in Lake have endorsed the plan. They asked the Board to adopt a resolution in support. After discussion, the following motion was offered.

The old apartments at the top of the hill on Route 31 and Cary Road are just about dismantled, and landscaping will begin soon to cover the area. The new Public Works Facility project will brought back to schedule soon. He has also spent time on the new budget for the department.

He has been working on the Zoning Ordinance update. Three new restaurants will are opening on Randall Road, Panera Bread, Red Robin, and A & W Root Beer.

The Wastewater Treatment Plant Phase 5D bid opening to take place. He is reviewing the Meyer Drive and Algonquin Road intersection improvement plans.

POLICE DEPARTMENT ~ Chief Laine reported the following:

Recent telephone outages at the Village hall area were caused by computer glitches, but the department was able to implement its emergency plan with no problems incurred. The new canine unit is completing their training. He has been working on collective bargaining.
