- 2. Moved by Steigert, seconded by Read, to reject all bids for the Arquilla Drainage Trough Bids. Roll call vote; voting aye Steigert, Smith, Read, Schmitt, Donner, Wolski. Motion carried; 6-ayes, 0-nays.
- 3. Moved by Steigert, seconded by Schmitt, to accept the bid and award the contract for the Phase 5 Division D Wastewater Treatment Plant Project to Manusos General Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$2,188,000.00

4. Moved by Steigert, seconded by Schmitt, to accept the bid and award the contract for the Wastewater Treatment Plant #1 Expansion (Pressure Filter Equipment) to Tonka Equipment Company in the amount of \$449,000.00
