VILLAGE MANAGER ~ Mr. Ganek reported the following:

There has been not update forthcoming regarding the western By-pass. This Thursday there will be a meeting with McHenry County regarding the County's Groundwater Management Plan. McHenry County Zoning Board will also hold a Public Hearing regarding the Duda property just north of the Village limits. It is 360 acres for residential development, and the Village staff will attend to gather information so as to help protect the Village's interest in this matter.

<u>PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR</u> ~ In the absence of Mr. Mitchard, Mr. Ganek reported the following:

Water Treatment Plant #3 is now supplying water during the daylight hours, and will be on twenty four hour operation in about ten days. The Wastewater Treatment plant design is about ninety percent completed. The E.P.A. must review the plan, and it should be ready to go out for bids in a month or two.

COMMUNITY PLANNING DIRECTOR ~ Mr. Mihelich reported the following:

The Public Arts Commission will meet tomorrow night. Elgin Community College is now offering business counseling for future entrepreneurs. The Community Development staff has submitted there budget for the upcoming fiscal year.

VILLAGE ENGINEER ~ Mr. Cuda reported the following:

His staff has also been working on various reviews of Village projects. Well #15 testing is continuing with power supplied by generators. His staff is also reviewing plans for the Randall Road, Bunker Hill interchange.

POLICE DEPARTMENT ~ Chief Laine reported the following:

The Police Commission continues to interview for recruitment of officers. March is set for the deadline. His staff is spending about ninety percent of their time working on the new department budget.

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VILLAGE ATTORNEY ~ Ms. Cahill reported the following:

Her Staff has been involved with property maintenance issues, and community development matters.
