

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, McHENRY & KANE COUNTIES, IL HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON MARCH 20, 2007

CALL TO ORDER: Village President John Schmitt brought the regular meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Village Clerk Jerry Kautz called the roll.

ROLL CALL: Present: Trustees John Spella, Robert Smith, Jerrold Glogowski, Jim Steigert, Brian Dianis, Barbara Read. A quorum was established. Staff in attendance: Administration – William Ganek, Michele Zimmerman, Jeff Mihelich, Russell Laine. Attorney – Kelly Cahill, Engineer – Frank Cuda.

PLEDGE TO FLAG: Village Clerk Kautz led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>ADOPT AGENDA</u>: Moved by Smith, seconded by Read, to adopt tonight's agenda as printed deleting item 16, Executive Session. Voice vote; ayes carried.

<u>PRESENTATION</u>: The first graduating class, "Angelwatch", from the Ted Spella Leadership School presented a donation of \$14,377 to the Village to help purchase the first "Lightning Protection Device" for Village parks. The Group thanked both AAYO and ALITHSA for assisting in fundraising.
