ADMINISTRATION ~ Mr. Ganek reported the following:

1- The Village fall recycling dropoff is next Monday at Presidential Park. 2- Towne Park is now officially closed until 2014 due to the western bypass construction. 3- Free leaf and brush pickup begins this week. 4- As of Wednesday, October 3, the village water status will change to green, "Water Conservation."

<u>COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT</u> ~ Mr. Farnum reported the following:

1- His staff is working on several items: the Public Art Program; the Downtown Partnership relating to bypass construction and ways to market the downtown area; and working on a solution for Riverside Plaza. 2- The Starbucks on Randall Road and Harnish Drive is open with the east side location doing a full remodeling.

<u>PUBLIC WORKS</u> ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

1- Edgewood Drive construction is moving forward quickly. Bike path paving is to begin tomorrow. Some grading issue are being resolved with a possible week delay but the project is still well ahead of schedule. Tree planting will begin this month. 2- Spring Creek Phase 3 project is facing some extra work but will be finished this year. 3- There are no village issues with the bypass construction.

<u>POLICE DEPARTMENT</u> ~ Deputy Chief Kuzynowski reported the following:

1- The DEA Drug Take-Back Program was successful with over 70 pounds of drugs collected. 2- The department has no issues with bypass construction traffic. 3- The fire district is allowing the department to have office space at their east side fire station on Cumberland.
