

Minutes of  
Algonquin Village Special Liquor Commission  
Held in Village Board Room Hall on April 2, 2013

CALL TO ORDER: With the Village Board seated as the Liquor Commission, Liquor Commissioner John Schmitt opened the meeting at 7:25 p.m. A roll call showed the following commissioners were present: Debby Sosine, Jim Steigert, Jerrold Glogowski, Robert Smith, Brian Dianis, John Spella. In attendance; Tim Schloneger, Village Manager; Russ Farnum, Community Development Director; Russ Laine; Chief of Police; Kelly Cahill, Attorney; and Jerry Kautz, Village Clerk.

CONSIDER LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION:

Mr. Schmitt requested that the Liquor Commission consider consenting to the approval of the following liquor license:

Class A-1

Kanji Corporation, d/b/a Rice Fusion Sushi, 2521-23 County Line Road, Algonquin, Illinois 60102 (Randall Crossing)

Mr. Schmitt reported all filing papers were submitted and in order. Attorney Cahill concurred.

The president, Ms. Rain Chen, was asked by Messrs. Dianis and Smith if BASSET training was given to all employees and if she knew of the severity of being caught sell to minors. She responded by saying their employees have been trained in BASSET and that any new hires would be trained before access to selling. She also stated her business will use an electronic swipe system to check IDs.

Ms. Cahill reported there is a legal matter of updating the corporate bylaws before issuing the liquor license. This will be done very soon.

Consensus of the Commission was to advise and consent to issuing this license pending the receipt of updated corporate bylaws.
