Arbor Hills Park

Arbor Hills Park and Stonegate Wetland is located on Stonegate Road. This area has been restored by the Village and is now a vibrant ecosystem that provides a home for terrestrial and aquatic species. The wetland helps to reduce flooding and cleans water.

Falcon Ridge Park


Located on Huntington Drive this restored natural area includes upland prairie and wetland areas. The wetlands are vital to improving water quality and preventing flooding. Enjoy the wildlife and native plants that abound.

High Hill Park

High Hill Park on Harnish Drive offers a playground, parking, ball fields, and trails along the natural area with interpretive signage. The park includes a steep hill.

Willoughby Farms Park

Located at the corner of Stonegate Road and Wynnfied Drive this park has it all. Enjoy sitting by the pond, playing tennis or basketball, watching a ball game, or dining in the picnic pavilion.
