Attorney Cahill reported all filing papers were submitted and in order. Police Chief Laine concurred.

Mr. Rauf, owner, was asked by Messrs. Dianis and Steigert if BASSET Training was given to all employees and if he knew of the severity of being caught selling to minors. He responded by saying their employees will be trained at the next BASSET session and that any new hires would be trained before access to selling. Also, they will use a computer cash register to check all IDs.

Consensus of the Commission was to advise and consent to issuing this license when at least one manager or employee in charge obtains BASSET Training.
