1. Trader Joe's East, Inc. d/b/a Trader Joe's #699 located at 1800 South Randall Road

First offense, pleaded guilty. Commissioner Schmitt levied a \$1K fine + costs and Basset Alcohol Training for all new employees.

2. Dajy, Inc. d/b/a Algonquin Food and Liquor located at 1117 South Main Street

Third offense for this business, pleaded guilty. Commissioner Schmitt levied a \$5K fine + costs, a 15 day suspension of license, and Basset Alcohol Training for all new employees. Mr. Glogowski said he did not think that this owner has taken these violations serious and said he would prefer a higher fine and longer suspension.

3. Battaglia's Pizza, Inc. d/b/a The Riverview Restaurant, Inc. at 1320 South Main Street

First offense, pleaded guilty. Commissioner Schmitt levied a \$1K fine + costs and Basset Alcohol Training for all new employees.
