AGENDA ITEM 1: Roll Call and Establish a Quorum

The Algonquin Public Library has once again generously agreed to serve as the exhibit location and host the event's opening reception. Artwork applications are due in early March and will be ready in time for the commission to review at its' March 19 meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 5: Update on 10th Anniversary Ships Set Sail Exhibit

The outdoor sculpture exhibit is being planned for May through October 2015. More than a dozen businesses and organizations have committed to sponsor the program and design a boat for display. The village will organize a launch party downtown in May, and the arts commission offered to assist a business sponsor looking for help with the design of their boat.
