

Minutes of
Algonquin Village Special Liquor Commission Meeting
Held in Village Board Room on August 11, 2015

CALL TO ORDER: Liquor Commissioner John Schmitt opened the meeting at 7:15 p.m. A roll call by Deputy Village Clerk Michelle Weber showed the following commissioners were present: Debby Sosine, Brian Dianis, Jim Steigert, Jerrold Glogowski, and John Spella. Absent: Bob Smith. Staff in attendance: Tim Schloneger, Village Manager; John Bucci, Police Chief. Village Attorney Kelly Cahill was also present.

(1) Consider Class F Liquor License for Coffee House Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Starbucks coffee #18024, 790 South Randall Road, Algonquin, Illinois

Staff reported all documents are in order with all fees paid.

Commissioners expressed initial concerns of their new business plan but after interviewing Starbucks staff and reviewing their policy it has put their minds at ease. Starbucks District Manager, Amy Hibbard also addressed their concerns indicating the one ID-one beverage policy, also all alcoholic beverages will be in glass containers making it easily identifiable to staff. The Commission also stressed that the village takes serving minors very seriously.

Consensus of the Commission was to advise and consent to issuing this license.
