Chairman Jolitz and the Members also discussed various budget issues, the Commission's possible receipt of a camera from the Village, and the need for a table top tripod and UV filter.


Members also discussed procedures for accepting and accessioning donations to the Commission, the Commission's various collections and storage of and access thereto, and other accessioning procedures.


Member Nee suggested and the members discussed a possible presentation to Algonquin Library staff educating them about the Commission's activities and the research resources it maintains.
