1. Fisholee Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Neros Pizza and Pub, at 300 Eastgate Court, Algonquin 60102

Tracy Fisholee in attendance representing the license holder.

This was their second offense the last dating back to 2010; they pleaded guilty to liquor violation, Selling Alcohol to Minors. Under questioning, Ms. Fisholee explained the circumstances; the bartender realized too late that she should have not handed the beers to the underage buyer. Commissioner Schmitt levied a \$2,000 fine plus court costs and a two day suspension to be administered on February 25 & 26, 2016. All Commission Members consented.

2. MPS Mart, Inc. d/b/a Citgo, 609 South Main Street, Algonquin 60102

Bito Babu represented himself as owner.

First offense, pleaded guilty to liquor violation, Selling Alcohol to Minors. Commissioner Schmitt levied a \$1,500.00 fine plus court costs for selling to a minor and that the clerk had no BASSET training. All Commission Members consented.
