Call to Order: Liquor Commissioner John Schmitt opened the meeting at 7:15 p.m. and requested Deputy Village Clerk Michelle Weber to call the roll.

- (1) Approve a Class B Liquor License for 31 Edgewood Inc. d/b/a Algonquin Tobacco & Liquor, 1117 S. Main Street, Algonquin, Illinois

All documents are in order and appropriate fees paid. Trustee Dianis asked Mr. Patel if he has had experience selling alcohol before. Mr. Patel explained he has been selling alcohol at a retail establishment for many years; he was part owner of the business he is purchasing. His partner is retiring and it was recommended that he purchase the business under a new entity. Mr. Dianis ask any any previous violation at the location? Deputy Chief Sutrick indicated he is was not aware of any violations.

- (2) Approve an Event Liquor License for St. Margaret Mary Parish, Annual Shamrock Shave Event

Ms. Burke, representing the Shamrock Shave committee, indicated she was not sure who was trained but thought someone was trained.
