

## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, McHENRY & KANE COUNTIES, IL HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON **JANUARY 6, 2009**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Village President John Schmitt brought the regular meeting to order at 8:05 PM. Village Clerk Jerry Kautz called the roll.

ROLL CALL: Present: Trustees Robert Smith, Jerry Glogowski, Deborah Sosine, Brian Dianis, John Spella, Jim Steigert. A quorum was established. Staff in attendance: Administration – William Ganek, Robert Mitchard, Russ Farnum, Jenna Kollings. Police - Russ Laine. Attorney - Kelly Cahill.

PLEDGE TO FLAG: Village Clerk Kautz led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADOPT AGENDA: Moved by Spella, seconded by Glogowski, to adopt tonight's agenda deleting Item 15, Executive Session. Voice vote; ayes carried.

AWARDS: Police Officers Schuett and Siegfort were recognized and received the Algonquin Police Lifesaving Award for their efforts in saving a fourteen-month old child who had fallen from a window. The child was not breathing when the officers arrived at the scene. They immediately started CRP and continued so until the paramedics arrived. These measures saved the life of this child.
