CALL TO ORDER: President Schmitt called tonight's meeting to order at 7:35 PM. ADMINISTRATION ~ Mr. Schloneger reporting:

1 - Illinois Route 31 Construction - Starting on Monday, the Illinois Department of Transportation will begin bridge work on IL-31 on the Ratt Creek Bridge between Edgewood Dr. and Beach Dr. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in the construction zone. Work is expected to last through the summer. We have information posted on our web site and other communication channels.

2 - Document Shredding Event - The Village will host a free document shredding event for residents on Saturday, June 18 at the Public Works Facility from 9:00am to Noon. This event is included with our franchise agreement with Groot.

3 - Swimming Pool Opens - The pool is now open for the summer season. With the recent warmer weather, we've had great attendance and season membership sales are up from last year.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ~ Mr. Farnum reported the following:

1 - "Art on the Fox" will be held Fathers Day Weekend with several new vendors and this year will have ice cream available from Colonial Café. Looking for a very successful event.

PUBLIC WORKS ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

2 - The department is trying to get various contracts that have been approved, moving along on streets projects.

POLICE DEPARTMENT ~ Chief Bucci reported the following:
