

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, McHENRY & KANE COUNTIES, IL HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON APRIL 7, 2009

CALL TO ORDER: Village President John Schmitt brought the regular meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Village Clerk Jerry Kautz called the roll.

<u>ROLL CALL</u>: Present: Trustees Robert Smith, Jerry Glogowski, Deborah Sosine, Brian Dianis, John Spella, Jim Steigert. A quorum was established. Staff in attendance: Administration – William Ganek, Robert Mitchard, Russ Farnum, Jenna Kollings. Police – Ed Urban. Attorney – Kelly Cahill.

PLEDGE TO FLAG: Village Clerk Kautz led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>ADOPT AGENDA</u>: Moved by Smith, seconded by Glogowski, to adopt tonight's agenda including Item 16, Executive Session, to discuss pending litigation and a personnel matter.

PUBLIC WORKS ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

The March 23rd storm created many problems for ComEd in particular with tree damage. The department processed over 100 work orders, and the new GIS system was used to track the damage and repairs. The new stimulus money will help resurface Huntington Drive from Randall Road to Route 31 according to IDOT. Mr. Mitchard recently met with ComEd to discuss future energy alternatives such wind technology. He hopes funding will be available in the future.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ~ Mr. Farnum reported the following:

T.J. Maxx will open on April 23rd. Binny's Beverage Depot will be installing their shelving soon. The department has been in communication with businesses to keep them in town and always looking for new companies to move to Algonquin. The Randall Road Crossing Plan input data has been distributed and will be discussed at a future Committee of the Whole.

ASST. VILLAGE MANAGER ~ Ms. Kollings reported the following:

A monthly newsletter will be emailed to residents who sign up for it. So far 250 have subscribed. A new Recreation Brochure will be ready this Wednesday, and the GIS internet is live and on the web.

POLICE DEPARTMENT ~ Deputy Chief Urban reported the following:

The department participated in a candlelight service on March 29th at Bunker Hill Drive to help the community remember the two young boys who were murdered recently in downstate Illinois. Officer Patricia Miller is now teaching DARE classes.
