

Minutes of Algonquin Village Liquor Commission Hearing held in Village Board Room on December 6, 2016

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: A roll call showed the following Commissioners were present: Debby Sosine, Brian Dianis, Jim Steigert, Jerrold Glogowski, Robert Smith, John Spella, John Schmitt.

Liquor Commissioner, John Schmitt, opened the hearing at 7:15 PM.

For Alleged Violations of Chapter 33, Liquor Control and Liquor Licensing, of the Algonquin Municipal Code and applicable sections of the Illinois Compiled Statutes Selling/Serving Alcohol to Minors

1. Prince & Jay, Inc., d/b/a 7-Eleven 1495 West Algonquin Road

Jitendra P Patel, owner/manager was the respondent of the violation and pleaded guilty to the charges of selling to a minor. After being warned by Commissioners on the seriousness of this occurrence, the penalty is a \$2,000 fine + court costs + BASSET training for servers, and a four-day liquor license suspension (December 15 -18, 2016). 2. Biaggi's Restaurant Italiano, LLC., d/b/a Biaggi's 1524 Randall Road

The Manager, Jason Chablani representing the company pleaded guilty to the charges of selling to a minor. The penalty is a \$1,000 fine + court costs + BASSET training for the new server.

All Commission Members consented.

3. PPB Restaurant, Inc., d/b/a Kostas Gyros 4053 West Algonquin Road The Corporation Secretary, Vasilios Sideris, and Daniel Nold, attorney representing the company pleaded guilty to the charges of selling to a minor and allowing a minor to server alcohol. The penalty is a \$1,000 fine + court costs + BASSET training for the new server. All Commission Members consented.
