Event tasks were assigned to various commission members as follows: Sapeta - volunteer recruitment; Kukreja and Knapp – kids art; Miller and Foster – business sponsorship; Laubenstein and Pelke – marketing. Ms. Farris will coordinate entertainment for the gazebo stage. Ms. Farris has setup Google Doc tracking forms that all commission members are encouraged to use to post progress updates for their respective tasks.

Short-term goals are for the kids art team to come up with two new ideas to share with the commission at the next meeting. Additionally, each commission member was asked to approach one local business and provide them with a copy of the new sponsorship packet that Ms. Farris updated for 2018. The commission's overall goal for 2018 is to attract \$2,000 in additional sponsorship revenue over the previous year.

Village Staff will contact Handmade on Main to discuss possible terms and changes to the ceramic art contest; the commission suggested either a fox or car as possible design molds. Staff will also work to setup a dedicated email address / account for the sponsorship team.

## AGENDA ITEM 7: Student Art Exhibit

Village Staff will coordinate with Sapeta just after the New Year, to send out the annual student art application forms and exhibit information to the local middle schools. The Algonquin Public Library will be unable to host the exhibit in 2018 due to ongoing construction and the commission suggested the Village consider purchasing portable display walls.
