VILLAGE MANAGER ~ Mr. Ganek reported the following:

Square Barn Road will be closed in June for sewer improvements. Mr. Mitchard will expound on this matter.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

It is necessary to close Square Barn Road from Algonquin Road to Huntley Road from June 12 to June 26 to afford the installation of the Westside Trunk Sewer. Local traffic only will be able to use the road. A few Cornish Park electrical issues have been resolved with Commonwealth Edison regarding the fountain and clock tower. Parts have to be ordered so a delay is necessary. Preliminary completion must be by mid July, and completely by late August. Water Treatment Plant #3 is now in full operation with computer programming still ongoing. Public works Staff is currently working on Algonquin Hill Climb planning and set up.

COMMUNITY PLANNING DIRECTOR ~ Mr. Mihelich reported the following:

New art work is being displayed in Village Hall lobby. The photographic display will continue until the end of July. A Public Hearing will be held to discuss the new Arbor Trail Park that is a small neighborhood park. The Planning & Zoning Commission will meet Monday to discuss a new retail store (Great Escape) on Randall Road. The fourth annual Community Conservation Day will be conducted on June 16.

The Old Oak Terrace project begins on June 27. Twisted Oak Ravine work continues.
