<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Village President John Schmitt brought the regular meeting to order at 8:00 PM. Village Clerk Jerry Kautz called the roll.

<u>COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE</u> ~ Trustee Spella read minutes from the November 22 Committee meeting. The minutes are on file at Village Hall for reviewing. The following Board action is required at this time.

General administration

At this time, Mr. Kevin McCanna, of Speer Financial, addressed the Board reporting that he had good news regarding the General Obligation Sewer Bonds and that Harris Bank was the best of eight bids received and would be most beneficial to the Village. It is recommended the Bonds be awarded to that bidder at a price of \$8,950,747.00 plus accrued interest being at a true interest rate of 4.0489%.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

The GIS database is being updated, also is the Building Standards Manual. The holiday decorations are being put is place. His staff is working on the department's operating budget. There have been three snowstorm events since the last Board meeting and the new Snow Plan is working nicely. President Schmitt asked about some street light fixtures being out for several months and asked what is being done. Mr. Mitchard replied that Commonwealth Edison (Com Ed) is very disorganized at this time and has been very lax in replacing lights and even installing service in some of Algonquin's new developments. The Village Board is upset with Com Ed, and Mr. Schmitt will be sending a letter of complaint on behalf of the Village to the Com Ed representative for our area.

<u>COMMUNITY PLANNING DIRECTOR</u> ~ Mr. Mihelich reported the following:

New businesses such as the west side Walgreen's, Oberweiss Dairy, and Giordano's are opening. Trader Joes's is getting close to opening and the east side Jewel Foods has broken ground for their new store.

<u>VILLAGE ENGINEER</u> ~ Mr. Cuda reported the following:

Bad weather has slowed the construction of the Well 15 well house. His office is working on various plan reviews for Community Development and reviewing stormwater plans.

<u>POLICE DEPARTMENT</u> ~ Chief Laine reported the following:

His department has been conducting BASSET training for liquor licenses holders. Also working on budget matters and hiring of new officers.

<u>VILLAGE ATTORNEY</u> ~ Ms. Cahill reported the following:

Her staff has been involved with ordinance drafting and reviews, and wastewater treatment plant expansion issues.
