Approve the Following Liquor Licenses:

A. Consider an A-1 Liquor License for Fu Chen, Inc. (dba) Kobe Sushi & Hibachi

Fu Chen Inc., (dba) Kobe Sushi & Hibachi, 209 S. Randall Road, Algonquin, Illinois 60102, has applied for a Class A-1 Liquor License (retail sale alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises). FU Chen Inc. has purchased Kobe Japanese Restaurant. The former owners are still managing the restaurant and will continue until the new owners receive their liquor license. Which at that time this new license would become effective and the former owners license would be relinquished. This license is only for the period ending April 30, 2020; it will then be renewed for the next fiscal year.

Mr. Zhou explained they are not changing servers, all servers are trained and have been servers for years. President Schmitt asked Deputy Chief Sutrick, that once the State License is obtained to ensure their servers are in compliance.
