ADMINISTRATION ~ Mr. Ganek reported the following:

1- Half-season pool passes are now on sale. Also, adult swimmers can now do evening laps at a small fee without a full pass.

<u>COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT</u> ~ Mr. Farnum reported the following:

1- Building inspections for Carpentersville have netted the Village \$10,000 thus far. 2-Gordmans Department Store will open this Thursday at 9 a.m. with the grand opening on July 29.

<u>PUBLIC WORKS</u> ~ Mr. Mitchard reported the following:

1- Beginning next week, repairs will be made on Bunker Hill by Jacobs High School. 2- The Village construction list is ahead of schedule for the year with punch lists being conducted. 3- Staff, along with the Village Engineer, has reviewed public improvements for Riverside Square (outside the property lines). 4- Staff is working on the storm cleanup. Fortunately, there is not a lot of damage within the Village; this is due to proper tree trimming.

<u>POLICE DEPARTMENT</u> ~ Deputy Chief Urban reported the following:

1- The department purchased new patrol radios which were within the annual budget. 2- They are working on Founders' Days manpower work list. 3- The department is in the process of replacing two crossing guards who left the Village; the replacements should be ready for the August 15 start of school.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Consider Motion Extending the Deadline for the Letter of Credit and Proof of Financing for the Riverside Plaza Settlement Agreement until December 1, 2011

Moved by Smith, seconded by Steigert, to extend the May 30, 2011 deadline outlined in the Settlement Agreement dated April 19, 2011 between the Village of Algonquin and Riverside Plaza Developers LLC regarding Riverside Plaza located at 1 North Main Street. This motion requires Riverside Plaza Developers LLC to file, with the Village, evidence of adequate financing to fully complete construction for final occupancy of the entire building

and requiring it to file, with the Village, a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$500,000 by December 1, 2011.

Roll call vote: voting aye – Steigert, Smith, Sosine, Dianis, Glogowski. Motion carried 5-ayes, 0-nays. 1-absent
