

MINUTES OF  
ALGONQUIN VILLAGE SPECIAL LIQUOR COMMISSION  
HELD IN VILLAGE HALL ON DECEMBER 6, 2011

---

CALL TO ORDER: With the Village Board seated as the Liquor Commission, Liquor Commissioner John Schmitt opened the meeting at 7:15 P.M. A roll call showed the following commissioners were present: Debby Sosine, Jim Steigert, Jerrold Glogowski, Brian Dianis. Absent; John Spella, Robert Smith. Staff in attendance: William Ganek, Russ Farnum, Russ Laine; Attorney Kelly Cahill; and Village Clerk Jerry Kautz.

CONSIDER LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION:

Mr. Schmitt requested that the Liquor Commission consider consenting to the approval of the following liquor license:

Class A-1

Don Marcos Mexican Restaurant LLC, d/b/a Don Marcos Mexican Restaurant, 1030/1036 East Algonquin Road, Algonquin, Illinois 60102 (formerly Bad Monkey)

Mr. Schmitt reported all documents, fees, and insurance are in order. Mr. Dianis welcomed them to the Village and then asked what type of training do the owners and employees have. The owners, Mark Garcia and Ann Carranza, responded that they are Bassett trained and will check all IDs. They were warned about the severity of serving minors and the consequences. After further discussion, the Commissioners consented to issuing the license.
