September 10 & 11 - Collection will be delayed by one day.

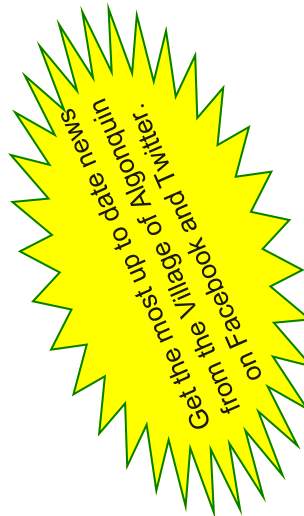
Christmas Tree Collection

Recycling Contamination

Electronic Waste Recycling

Groot offers curbside collection of electronics. To Schedule a pickup of electronics, residents must call Groot directly at least 24 hours in advance of your scheduled waste/trash collection day. A scheduled collection of electronic waste shall require a \$30.00 charge plus \$5.00 per item, unlimited items.

Free Leaf and Brush Collection

Groot will provide free collection of leaves and branches October 3 through December 13, 2019, on your regular collection day. Branches must not exceed 2 inches in diameter and should be tied in bundles that are not more than 4 feet in length, 24 inches in diameter, and 50 pounds in weight. Leaves must be placed in standard paper yard waste bags or reusable containers that are clearly marked with a red "X." Place reusable containers or bags at the curb on your regular collection day. **Leaves placed in loose piles will NOT be collected.**

Grass clippings and other yard waste will still require a collection sticker. Any bags or cans that contain leaves mixed with other yard waste will also require a collection sticker. Garbage and yard waste stickers are interchangeable.

Many of us want to do our part when it comes to preserving our environment. Here in Algonquin, it is one of our highest priorities. However, over the years there has been a trend towards the loss of a significant percentage of our recyclable goods. This is because they are shipped to landfills. This results from contaminated materials making it into the recycling process. When contaminants enter this process, a remarkable number of the valuable recyclables are tossed out with the unusable. Within the past 12 years, residents of Algonquin have discarded an average of 13,073 tons of recyclables each year. However, 11 percent (approximately 1440 tons) of those items were unable to be recycled due to contamination. Below are guidelines to help you recycle responsibly.

Replace lids & caps

METAL
Steel & Aluminum Containers and Foil

PAPER
Cardboard (flattened),
Office Paper, Newspaper, Magazines

GLASS
Containers: Bottles & Jars Only

PLASTIC
Containers: Bottles, Tubs, Jugs,
and Jars Only

CARTONS
May be acceptable in some
programs, check with
local authority.

NO!
Put material in loose
- Not in Bags

No Plastic Bags
No Product Wrap
(return clean to retailer)

No Big Items (Electronics, Wood,
Propane Tanks, Scrap Metal or Styrofoam –
check with local authority for other options)

No Tanglers (Hangers, Hoses,
Wire, Cords, Ropes or Chains)

Textiles or Shoes (donate)

**No Food, Liquid, Diapers,
Batteries or Needles**

No Shredded Paper
(check with local authority
for other recycling options)
