



# IRRIGATION SYSTEM Permit Application Checklist

## Required Permit Applications:

## Submittal Requirements:

- ❖ **New Install**
  - For paper submission, Two (2) copies of Plat of Survey indicating the location of each sprinkler head / For online submission, One (1) copy of Plat of Survey
  - Waiver
  - Letter of Intent
- ❖ **Irrigation Removal – Cap Off**
  - None

## Permit Fees (Fee is not due until permit is ready):

- ❖ New Install: \$0.75 per head with a minimum permit fee of \$80.00
- ❖ Irrigation Removal - None

## License Requirements:

- ❖ Plumbing

## Other Requirements & Information:

- ❖ Work must be started and completed within six (6) months of the issue date.
- ❖ All installations must be performed by an Illinois licensed plumber.
- ❖ A RPZ backflow preventer with a strainer shall be installed according to the Illinois State Plumbing Code.
- ❖ Sprinkler heads can be placed in the Village's right of way. The sprinkler heads need to remain twelve (12) inches from the curb. A waiver of liability form signed by the property owner needs to be filed with the permit application.
- ❖ Irrigation removal must be capped off 2 feet of the shutoff valve in the house.
- ❖ Individual subdivision covenants may have special requirements and restrictions. It is up to homeowner to receive Home Owner's Association approval.
- ❖ After Permit is issued, as construction progresses, inspections are required. [Click here to schedule inspections online](#). Or call us at 847-658-2700 # 1003.
