ACTIVITIES:


Commission Members discussed ongoing efforts to expand content on the Commission's webpage on the Village website and/or any social media sites, including possible information regarding a series on various local historic sites.

Commission Members also met and discussed with visitors, Garden Club President Slonke and Member Weinhammer, about the Hitchcock Design Group's final proposed plans and cost opinion for restoration of the historic Mineral Spring site in Town Park and efforts to support it. Garden Club members expressed their commitment to provide and install plantings and vegetation at the Mineral Spring site, and thereby reduce the expenditures contemplated by the Hitchcock Design Group's Cost Opinion for those items. The Commission also provided information to them that they requested including copies of historic documents regarding the former Algonquin Woman's Club to the visiting Garden Club members, who are researching the Woman's Club's historic role in petitioning Algonquin to acquire Towne Park in 1915-16 and work to create the historic Mineral Springs site enhancements in the Park in 1916.
