

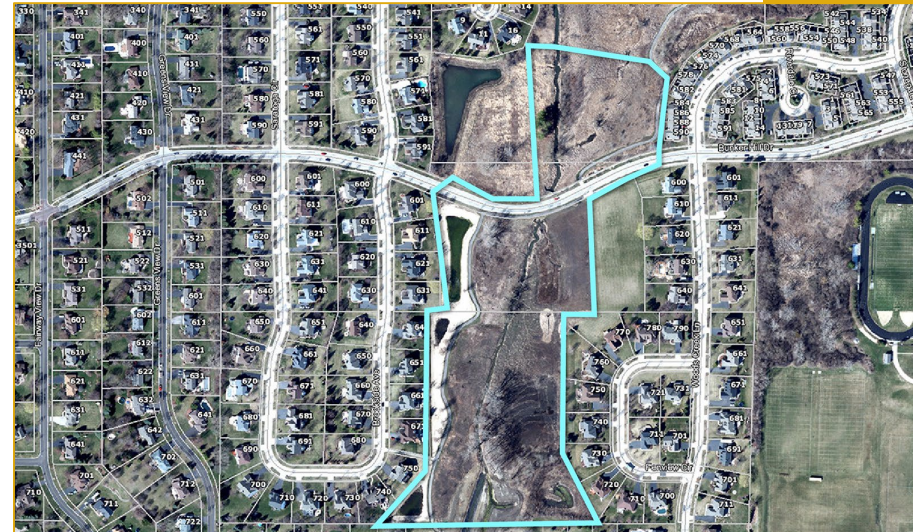
Woods Creek Reach 5 Ecological Restoration

Project Information

This project includes the stabilization of the stream, removal of invasive trees and shrubs and the planting of native vegetation along Woods Creek from just north of Bunker Hill Drive to approximately Woods Creek Lane. Invasive plantings degrade natural spaces and streams and are harmful to wildlife and other plants as they can spread and overtake natural resources. Once complete, Woods Creek will be restored to a beautiful area with native plants. Native plants allow for groundwater infiltration, and they also filter stormwater pollutants as they run off lawns and streets, allowing for cleaner creeks and streams.



Stabilizing the creek helps to prevent erosion when there are heavy rain events. This keeps the stream corridor intact and also reduces poor water quality issues that result from sediment in the water.
