WRITTEN EXAMINATION

A **mandatory** written test will be held at *Western Illinois University (Macomb Campus) on Tuesday, April 25, 2023 at 5:00pm and the Village of Algonquin Ganek Municipal Center, 2200 Harnish Drive, Algonquin, IL on Saturday, May 20, 2023 at 8:00am, Tuesday, May 23, 2023 at 9:00am and Wednesday, May 24, 2023 at 5:00pm.* **You will be contacted by Village staff with a calendar link to schedule your preferred testing date/time once your application is submitted so be sure to add @algonquin.org to your spam filter. You may only attend one session.**

Applicants must present a U.S. federal or state-issued photo ID card or driver's license to enter the testing site(s). College, university, library, and other non-governmental IDs are not acceptable. The

doors will be closed and locked promptly at the testing time and any applicant arriving after the specified time or without a current application on file for this recruitment will not be allowed to enter.

The entire testing process may include a physical fitness test, written test, oral interview, polygraph, psychological test, medical exam, and any other exams deemed necessary by the Police Department.
